

Growth Birth of a dragonfly

- X Touch the cross to close a window.




The mother lays her eggs on the water. They are covered with a kind of jelly which makes them sink.



The egg of the dragonfly rests underwater.


In time a tiny spider-like nymph hatches out.







When the baby dragonflies hatch out of their eggs they wander about at the bottom of the pond.

They live in this way for 2 or 3 years, feeding and breathing like fish.



All winter the nymph grows steadily, living in the water. When the summer comes it climbs a plant-stem into the fresh air.





For 6 to 8 weeks it flies in the air as an adult dragonfly.
