ProLanguage is a network of academic institutions and non-academic organizations working with refugees. Adopting a cross-disciplinary approach, it aims to identify research agendas on the facilitating role of language in refugee settings; promote dissemination of already existing survey and research data; provide an evidence base for current language policies and practices in refugee settings in Lebanon, Greece and Italy; discuss the effectiveness of these policies or practices; and transfer good practice across the different settings. Three meetings are being held in Patras, Palermo and Beirut, followed by a final conference in summer 2018.
