#### **Expectations**

We understand that you may have other commitments and will look at rescheduling if a significant number of you can't attend a particular event.

If you register for an activity and are no longer able to attend, please let the organisers and the Scenario Admin Manager know as soon as possible – with every activity there is a both a financial cost and a time cost for the organisers: the sooner you let us know the more likely we can adjust numbers.
